

INVITATION TO POTENTIAL SUPPLIERS OF GOODS AND SERVICES TO REGISTER ON THE CITY OF JOBURG'S SUPPLIER DATABASE

Does your company have women, youth or/and people with disabilities as shareholders?

Is it based within the Municipal boundaries of Johannesburg?

Is it registered on the City of Joburg's database of suppliers for goods and services that the City may want to procure?

The Department of Community Development in the City of Joburg is facilitating a special project to register companies owned by **youth, women and People with Disabilities** on the City's supplier database for the provision of goods and services. Qualifying companies will also be registered on a follow up incubation programme aimed at facilitating access to possible procurement opportunities.

The Municipal Finance Management Act of 2003 compels the City of Johannesburg to procure services and goods only from suppliers who are accredited to the City's supplier database. The database has been created to afford suppliers a 'fair, transparent and equitable' process to access business opportunities in the City.

Note that any company can register on the database; however, the Department of Community Development will be targeting companies owned by women, youth and people with disabilities for this project.
